

DEATH OF E. W. LEWIS.

He Expired Suddenly at his
Home Saturday.

Mr. E. W. Lewis, one of the county's oldest and most prosperous citizens died very suddenly at his home near Buff Saturday afternoon.

He appeared in as good health as usual at noon Saturday and ate dinner with the usual relish. After dinner he walked out on the porch and sat down in a chair and in a few moments fell over in an unconscious condition. He was at once carried into the house but all efforts to revive him were useless and in a short time he was dead.

Mr. Lewis came to this county from Forsyth county several years ago and soon became one of the most extensive land owners in the county. He bought a number of large farms but most of his property has since been transferred to his children.
