W. B. Lingo, who one week ago took 50 grains of bichloride of mercury with suicidal intent, died at Dublin, Ga., and was buried in North View cemetery. For the first several days after the dose had been taken, it was thought that he would recover, but he gradually grew worse and died in agony. He was about 25 years of age and is survived by a wife and three children.
