

# Frank L. Linn Dies at Folsom Sunday, Feb. 22

The Folsom Community and much of North Georgia was shocked and saddened to learn of the death of Mr. Frank Linn, at his Folsom home, Sunday night, Feb. 22nd.

Mr. Linn taught school at Belcher School in Gordon County in 1897 and Folsom in 1898. He later attended State Normal at Athens, and Augusta Medical School.

Feb. 14, 1901, he was married to Miss Ida Hill and to this union were born two children, Sam L. Linn, who with his wife and four children live with his mother, and Blanche Linn, a daughter, who died April 21, 1927.

Mr. Linn was a rural mail carrier for ten years, from 1906 to 1915, working out from the post office then located in Folsom.

He died on the 41st anniversary of his mother's death, and was buried on his daughter's birthday.

Many of Mr. Linn's former school pupils attended funeral services, which were held from the home, Wednesday afternoon, Feb. 25, and conducted by Rev. Walter Adams, of Covington, Ga., a class mate and close friend.

Mr. Linn is survived by his wife, Mrs. Ida H. Linn; one son, Sam L. Linn; four grandchildren; one sister, Mrs. J. J. Floyd, Adairsville Route Two; two brothers, R. L. Linn, of Rydal, Ga., Route Two, and A. L. Linn, of Forsyth, Ga.

Young and old alike feel his passing keenly. Knowing a true friend has left us, but feeling also our lives are richer and fuller for having known him. *Mar 5 1948*
