Two men die in wrecks

Two Gordon County residents were killed in separate automobile accidents Sunday.

According to Gordon County Coroner James Carver, Roy Louis Lucas, 33, of West Drive was pronounced dead at the scene of a one-vehicle accident on Dews Pond Road.

A report from the Georgia State Patrol said that a resident along the road heard a noise around 2 a.m. and that he checked but did not see the accident. Lucas' vehicle was found at approximately 7:15 a.m. by a motorist who called 911.

Lucas was traveling west on Dews Pond Road, the report said, when he apparently lost control of the 1984 Chevrolet Monte Carlo he was driving.

The vehicle, owned by Daniel Evans White of Erwin Hill Road, left the roadway and traveled ap-

proximately 68 feet before coming to rest off the roadway.

Lucas was trapped in the vehicle, and extrication equipment was used to release him from the wreckage.

The vehicle was extensively damaged.
