

**THE REV. ROSS
MADDOX**

The Rev. Ross Maddox, age 62, of 2455 Lakeland Dr., Dalton, was accidentally killed Monday, Oct. 13, 1975 at 3 p.m. while working with the L & N Railroad.

The Rev. Maddox had been employed by the L & N Railroad for the past 29 years. He was the son of the late John Henry and Mamie Lee Ford Maddox and a member of the Bethlehem Baptist Church in Whitfield County. He was a Baptist minister, having served as pastor of the Rayes Chapel Baptist Church. He had been a resident of Whitfield County several years.

The Rev. Mr. Maddox is survived by his wife, the former Willie Mae Flowers of Dalton; one daughter, Diane Shelton of Dalton; three sons, John Henry Maddox, Carl Lester Maddox and Walter Leonard Maddox, all of Dalton; two sisters, Mrs. Sarah Smith of Rome and Clara Melton of Lindale; one brother, Clarence Maddox of Carbondale.
